POST EVENT REPORT

Finished Vehicle Logistics North America

OVERVIEW

EVENT WEBSITE

The North American vehicle logistics industry is going through a paradigm shift in inventory strategy, transport capacity, technology and partnerships. This transformation could be seen in full force at Finished Vehicle Logistics North America, which saw record attendance, and featured the most important leaders in the sector coming together in search of solutions and partners.

The event demonstrated the scale of vehicle logistics capacity and lead time challenges. OEMs including Stellantis, GM, Nissan and Volkswagen Group all made it clear that they were in need of greater capacity and service from providers. Nick Thompson at Stellantis pointed to an urgent need for investment in rail, ro-ro shipping and off-site storage, especially in Mexico. GM's Anthony Clevio highlighted how rising production for the carmaker in the Midwest and Mexico was leading to significant changes in its logistics network and the requirement for more joined-up logistics services. GM, Stellantis and Hyundai highlighted challenges in managing the 'land bridge' connecting imports on the West Coast from Asia and Mexico across the country via rail.

Another major topic was on preparing for EV and setting standards for EV. OEMs and LSPs made the case for greater weight tolerances, which Toks Omishakin, secretary of transportation for California, said the state government would consider. OEMs including Lucid and Hyundai also stressed the need for systems and solutions to help EV makers manage the state of charge across yards and logistics.

While the industry faces challenges, many presented solutions: Nissan is re-designing its network around dense clusters rather than states; GM has been able to quickly pivot to new transport flows; Ford and Toyota are using more digital technology across processes; Mercedes-Benz is investing in upskilling people to handle EV and improve safety.

The event made it clear that, although vehicle logistics is facing delays, higher costs and bottlenecks, it is vibrant with innovation and investment, and that stakeholders are ready to work more closely together than ever before.
